



The Arnold School of Public Health at the University of South Carolina invites applications and nominations for the position of Professor and Chair of the Department of Health Services Policy and Management.

The University of South Carolina has been designated a “very high research activity” institution by the Carnegie Foundation for the Advancement of Teaching and offers multiple venues for research collaboration across the schools and colleges of public health, medicine, nursing, pharmacy, social work, law, and business. The Department houses a HRSA-funded rural health research center and Department faculty direct an NIH-funded EXPORT grant addressing health disparities. The Department also maintains strong connections with state and Federal agencies, and leading health care organizations in the state, including Palmetto Health Alliance (PH) and Greenville Hospital System (GHS). The latter provide research and network access to large clinical enterprises. Additional developmental opportunities are available through Health Sciences South Carolina (HSSC), an innovative collaborative entity composed of USC, GHS, PH, Spartanburg Regional Medical System, Clemson University and the Medical University of SC with its affiliated health care system. HSSC sponsors a number of cutting edge research centers with endowed chair professors and is launching an ambitious program of clinical translational research that offers unparalleled possibilities for statewide programs.

The Department is highly committed to its educational mission and offers courses in both campus and distance education formats. It offers a Master of Healthcare Administration accredited by the Commission for Accreditation of Healthcare Management Education and a Master of Public Health accredited by the Council on Education for Public Health, as well as both resident and international PhD and DrPH degrees.

Applicants should have an advanced degree (Ph.D., Dr.PH., or equivalent) in health policy, health administration, health economics, public policy, or other related health policy discipline. Candidates should have an established record of research, teaching and extramural funding commensurate with appointment at the rank of full professor. Other essential qualifications include

- Administrative experience in leading programs/departments,
- Commitment to foster and manage diversity
- Ability to mentor junior faculty and promote an expanding research agenda,
- Leadership that is collaborative and transparent,
- Maintain strong ties with adjunct faculty, alumni, and health care agencies and institutions across the state
- Vision to lead the Department’s growth in its research, teaching and service missions
